# AMERICAN AIRFIELDS TRIP SUMMARY

As of 1942, the arrival of hundreds of U.S. airmen into southeastern Britain marked the start of a critical tactical partnership between the RAF and the USAAF that would extend to the final days of WWII. This personal heritage journey puts you on a path to discovery, tracing the rich history of American war and aviation history in England. Explore the narrative of Winston Churchill, the man who led the wartime initiatives of Britain alongside the other Allied forces. Pay your respects at the peaceful Cambridge American Cemetery and Memorial, and at the famed Duxford Airfield, gain insight into the lives of airmen as you visit the American Air Museum and the Imperial War Museum. Slip out into the countryside to bear witness to the historic American airfields that dot the green landscape, then make your way to the English coast where the iconic white cliffs of Dover greeted enemy aircraft with anti-aircraft weaponry, securing the airspace over the English Channel. Trace your relatives back to their WWII air missions, learning about yourself in the process.

DAY 2 - Thu, Oct 2, 2025: London

## **Strolling the Magical Streets**

Meet your private driver and guide, and set out on a full day tour to familiarize yourself with London's signature sights. In order to avoid the crowds later in the day, you'll first make your way to the majestic Tower of London, heading through London's historic center, passing Pudding Lane where the Great Fire of London started in 1666. Upon arrival, you'll visit the Tower, an 11th century castle initiated by William the Conqueror, classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home of the priceless Crown Jewels. From there, head through the City of London, home to the Bank of London and the London Stock Exchange. Continue to Westminster, renowned home of Hyde Park, the Houses of Parliament with Big Ben, Piccadilly Circus, Bond Street, and more. Here you'll visit the iconic Westminster Abbey, coronation and burial site for English monarchs dating back to 1066. Immerse yourself in this landmark of English history, rich in celebration and ceremony.

#### DAY 3 - Fri, Oct 3, 2025: London

## A Walk Through the Past

Meet your private driver and guide for a tour of Churchill's War Rooms and the Imperial War Museum. Discover the original Cabinet War Rooms, the wartime bunker which sheltered Churchill and his staff during the Blitz. These historic rooms once buzzed with planning and plotting, strategies and secrets, and today you can explore the subterranean headquarters to experience the secret history that lives on, under ground. Next take some time to explore the 6 floors of London's Imperial War Museum. Visit the many different exhibits housed in this spectacular building including the First World War Galleries, the Lord Ashcroft Gallery to Extraordinary Heroes (an extensive display of military service medals dating from the Crimean War) and the award-winning Holocaust Exhibition, which helps to illustrate the Nazi persecution of the Jews and other groups before and during the Second World War. Conclude on arrival back to your hotel.

This afternoon, enjoy time at leisure to explore at your own pace, or relax at your hotel.

DAY 4 - Sat, Oct 4, 2025: London To Cambridge

### A Journey Back in Time

After checkout, meet your private driver-guide for a transfer to Cambridge, experiencing the nearby Cambridge American Cemetery and Memorial en route. Donated by the University of Cambridge, this 30-acre American Military grave site lies on a gentle slope, framed by woodland. It's home to the remains of 3,811 U.S. war dead from WWII, and the names of 5,127 others are recorded on the Walls of the Missing. Stroll the grounds and take some time to pay your respects at this solemn site. Afterward, visit the 4,000 square foot visitor center where you'll have an opportunity to discover a number of interpretive exhibits, with photos, films, personal stories, and even interactive displays. Conclude your day on arrival to your new hotel in Cambridge.

Enjoy some free time to explore the charming town of Cambridge on your own. Why not take a stroll to see some of the campuses of its world-famous university? Wander through its breathtaking botanical gardens set across 40 acres, or visit the Fitzwilliam Museum and marvel at its collection of rare art and antiques.

## A Healthy Dose of History

Set out with your private driver-guide on a day tour to Dover, discovering the Dover Castle, Western Heights, and the Battle of Britain Memorial. Known as the 'Lock and Key of England,' due to its geographical position as the UK's closest point to mainland Europe, Dover is famed for its picturesque, chalky white cliffs. While in Dover, you'll visit the 11th century Dover Castle, a massive medieval construct which was built by William I following his invasion of England in 1066. While you make your way through the castle's defensive walls, enjoy the view out to sea, spotting France on the horizon, only 30 miles away. A rare, restored WWI anti-aircraft gun has been relocated to Dover Castle, and is on display for visitors. Nearby, discover some of Britain's most impressive fortifications at the 19th century Western Heights, with its North Bastion and Drop Redoubt fort. Finally, pause for a visit to pay your respects at the Battle of Britain Memorial, a monument honoring the aircrew who flew in the 1940 Battle of Britain military campaign during WWII. Conclude your day on arrival back to Canterbury.

#### Cross an Item off the Bucket List

Today, you'll make your way back to London in the company of your private driver-guide, taking time to visit Chartwell en route, Winston Churchill's famed country house. Now owned by the National Trust, Chartwell was Churchill's home for over four decades, and its rooms are preserved in the same way they were when he and his wife lived there. Explore the house, discover his painting studio, and enjoy the lovely views from the landscaped garden. For many war history buffs, or those with British heritage, this is often a true bucket-list experience.
